WINDTHORST FEDERAL CREDIT UNION ANNUAL MEETING AND ELECTION NOTICE

Windthorst Federal Credit Union will hold its Annual Meeting at 11:30 a.m. on Sunday, February 23, 2025. The Annual Meeting will be held at St. Mary's Parish Hall which has a physical address of **349 St. Mary's Street, Windthorst, Texas 76389**.

This year there are three positions open for election on the Board of Directors. After careful review, the Nominating Committee, appointed by the Chairman of the Board of Directors, has nominated one member for each Board position to be filled. The term for each position is three years and the three nominees are as follows:

Charles Veitenheimer (incumbent)

Gary Wolf (incumbent)

Keelan Lewis Yoder

A brief statement of qualifications and biographical data for each of the nominees is included with this notice.

Charles Veitenheimer (incumbent) was raised in Windthorst, TX where he & his wife Mitzi still reside. They have 3 children and 14 grandchildren. Charles is a graduate of Windthorst High School and has been self-employed in the dairy, oilfield and farm and ranching industries. He is a member of the Knights of Columbus and St. Mary's Catholic Church and has served on the Windthorst VFD and Windthorst ISD School Board. Charles has been a WFCU board of director for 29 years where he has served on the credit committee & ALCO and held the position of Vice-President and Secretary.

Gary Wolf (incumbent) is a graduate of Windthorst High School and Tarleton State University where he graduated with a BA in Animal Science. He has experience in the dairy, farming and cattle industries. Gary & his wife Mary live in Windthorst, TX where they raised their 3 children and are proud grandparents of two grandsons. Gary is President of Catholic Life Insurance Branch #30. He also is a member of Knights of Columbus #1824 & St. Mary's Catholic Church. Gary has also served on the Windthorst ISD School board and various Dairy councils & organizations. He has been a WFCU board member for 14 years where he has served as President as well as serving on the Credit Committee and Executive Committee.

Dr. Keelan Yoder DVM grew up on a century old family farm in Bowie Texas. She received her bachelor's degree at Texas A&M University in Animal Science and Rangeland Management in 2007 and attended Virginia Tech for her doctorate, graduating in 2011. She serves as majority owner and CFO of Salt Creek Veterinary Hospital, PLLC. Salt Creek Veterinary Hospital is a group of six mixed animal practices across north Texas, caring for both large and small animals. She proudly serves on Archer County Show board and loves supporting youth introduction into agriculture. She lives in Windthorst with her husband, Ryan Yoder, who is owner and operator of RY Ag, a custom agricultural spray business. Their four children are active in sports and showing livestock.

Further nominations may be made by official petition signed by 34 eligible members. Official petitions and the rules and instructions for the completion of the official petition may be obtained by contacting Ms. Judy L. Koetter, President/CEO, at the Credit Union office which is located at 14205 W. FM 174, Windthorst, Texas 76389, between the hours of 9 a.m. and 4 p.m. Monday through Friday. Official petitions must be completed in full compliance with the election rules as set forth in the rules and instructions for the completion of the official petition and must include each signer's signature and printed name, the last 4 digits of the signer's member number, and the signer's complete address and telephone number. Members who are 18 years of age or older and who meet certain requirements under the Federal Credit Union Act are eligible for election. Official petitions must be accompanied by a signed certificate from the nominee that he or she is agreeable to the nomination and will accept office if elected and should also include a brief statement of qualifications and biographical data. Elected officials are legally responsible for the fiscal integrity of the Credit Union and for compliance with State and Federal laws.

Official petitions must be filed with the Secretary of the Board of Directors at the Credit Union office which is located at 14205 W. FM 174, Windthorst, Texas 76389, by 4:00 p.m. on November 15, 2024, which is the closing date for receiving nominations by petition. If no official petitions are received by 4:00 p.m. on November 15, 2024, there will be no election by ballot and no nominations from the floor. When only one member is nominated for each position to be filled, each nominee shall be deemed elected by general consent or acclamation. If there is more than one nominee for any position to be filled, the election will be conducted by ballot boxes or voting machines. In such event, the election shall be determined by plurality vote.
